

Templer Park

This park is a major eco-tourism destination in Selangor due to its proximity to Kuala Lumpur. It is named the British High Commissioner, Sir Gerard Templer, who was instrumental in its establishment.

Every weekend, hundreds of picnickers throng this pristine green haven, seeking respite from the city. The jungle streams with their cool clear water are perfect for a refreshing dip. For the more adventurous, there are several jungle trails to be explored.

Getting There By Rail

Take the KTM Komuter to Port Klang Terminal. The jetty to Pulau Ketam is just a few meters away. Ferry service is available everyday and the journey takes 30 minutes.

By Boat

If you are driving, take the Federal Highway and follow the sign board to Port Klang (Southport). You can park your car at the KTM Terminal. From Southport, the boat ride to Pulau Ketam takes about 30 minutes.
